

## NEWSLETTER SPRING 2012




### Boat Trial

Steve and Lynda Holmes "KNOT TO BAD" are at Townsville after having been up to Hinchinbrook passage.


Eric and Janelle Bulley "BULLEYE" are still enjoying the Townsville warmth and are not expected back until November.



The clubs financial details were presented to the meeting and agreed to by vote.




