It costs the club all its membership fees to have these moorings so don't feel bad about asking boats that are illegally using them to move along.

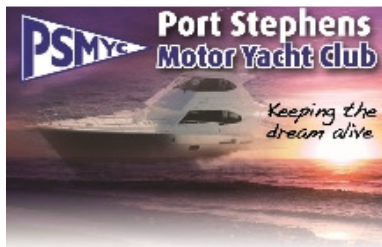

Colin and Sandy Brown (EAGLE) has moved down to Sydney we wish them well.

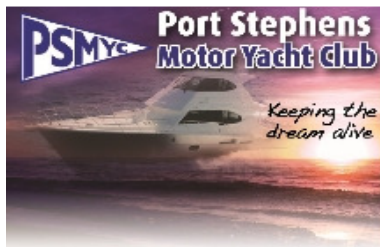
Eric and Janelle Bulley (BULLEYE) are at the Whitsundays for winter for there annual migration.
