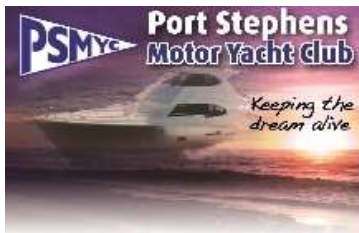
WELCOME TO THE CLUB

- Mick and Raylee O'Connell who have moved to the Gold Coast

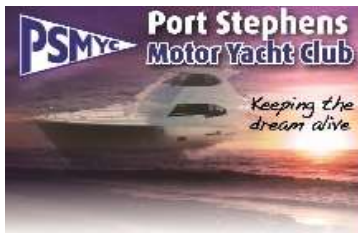
Club Mooring Issues

Barnes Rock

As members would be aware we had made application in the usual way to RMS for a permit to locate a mooring at this location and that was successful with RMS. When we proceeded to install the mooring that approval was overruled by the Marine Parks Authority on the grounds that approval would set a precedent and that we needed to apply for its further approval via their department. This has now recently been resubmitted with nothing heard at this time. We will keep members informed and hopefully we will be able to report a positive outcome.

All club moorings, nine (9) in total are scheduled to be serviced during September and October.

Membership Fees for 2018/19

The invoice for your membership will be in the mail to you in coming days and we would ask your assistance in attending to these promptly.

This year due to the increased cost of maritime NSW fees along with higher maintenance costs our annual fee has had to increase for the first time in 6 years from \$130.00 to \$150.00.

For the information of members, you will find outlined below are the costs associated with maintaining each (1) mooring per annum.

Maritime NSW licence fee:	\$425.00
Service contractor Costs:	\$300.00
Total.	\$725.00

These costs do not include the capital cost of buying the mooring (buoy, chain, ropes and weight) which is normally between \$800.00 and \$1000.00.

Club Burgee's and Mooring Use.

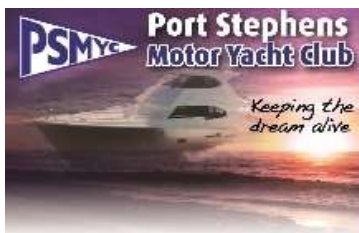
It's important that members display the club burgee particularly when using our moorings so that we can identify legitimate users and also assist RMS to enforce during their patrols club member use only.
