For the information of all members the club leases from Maritime NSW 10 Mooring sites. These moorings cost the club \$3740 per year. On top of this each mooring has to have a yearly service which last year costs the club \$3101= a total of \$6841.

We currently have 60 member boats who pay an annual subscription of \$130 which totals \$7800 which gives us an annual surplus of approx. \$1000.

This \$1000 has to cover the following:

Postage & Stationary, Internet hosting costs, Annual return fees, Membership cards & PSMYC Burgees.

The committee tries to make sure that each and every event that we hold nearly breaks even. For example the 2010 Christmas party lost \$429.
